

Dr. Jamil Mahuad



Dr. Jamil Mahuad (Doctor in Jurisprudence, Catholic University of Ecuador, 1975; Master in Public Administration, Harvard Kennedy School of Government, 1989) served as President of Ecuador (August 1998 to January 2000), capping a career of nearly 20 years in Ecuadorian politics, which included two terms as Mayor of Quito (1992-1998) and as member of the National Congress.

He is delighted to serve alongside Erica Ariel Fox as Beyond Yes™ for the Common Good co-Chair.

Mr. Mahuad is a Nobel Peace Prize Nominee (1999) for the signing of a definitive Peace Treaty with neighbor country Peru that in the words of President Clinton “ended the longest source of armed conflict in this Hemisphere.” The World Wild Fund granted to Mr. Mahuad the *Gift to the Earth Award* (1999) in recognition to his decisive pro-environmental policies to protect the Ecuadorian Amazonia.

Mr. Mahuad is Co-Director of the Project on the Prevention of Global Violence, part of the Harvard Institute on Global Health (HIGH), under the office of the President of Harvard University. (2009-present); Co-founder and Senior Adviser of the Harvard International Negotiation Program, at Harvard Law School (2004-Present), where he has been co-teaching with Professor Daniel Shapiro, *Dealing with Emotions in Business Negotiations*, an Executive Education Program based on the book *Beyond Reason*, by Roger Fisher and Daniel Shapiro, which has Mr. Mahuad’s contributing chapter.

Mr. Mahuad is a Board Member of The Abraham Path Initiative (2008-present) and of The Medici Summit: Where Business and Innovation Intersect (2008-present) and member of the Global Advisory Council Member of Mediators Beyond Borders (2009-present).

Mr. Mahuad currently lectures at universities, congresses and public and private organizations across the world, on Negotiation, Mediation, Leadership, and the challenges facing struggling democracies in the age of globalization. Mr. Mahuad has been a visiting professor and

lecturer in universities in various continents including The University of Tokyo, Keio University, American University of Beirut, Instituto Tecnológico de Monterrey, sede Queretaro; the Sloan School of Management at MIT, Yale University, University of Chicago, University of Notre Dame, University of Indiana, George Washington University, the Institute for Conflict Analysis and Resolution at George Mason University, Babson College, University of Saint Gallen, Geneva School of Diplomacy; Fletcher School, Boston University, Northeastern University, Amherst University, U S Army College. He has five honorary degrees from universities in Peru and Ecuador.
